## Game Plan: Operation Overlooked

**Identify** overlooked variables

**Evaluate** their relationship with the opioid crisis

Analyze their effect on specific subpopulations



### Step 1: Identify overlooked variables

- Political party in power (proportions of Democratic/Republican representatives in the House of Representative)
- Altitude (feet)
- Minimum wage (USD)
- Veterans: total (count), disabled (%), unemployed (%), impoverished (%)
- Veterinarians (count)



## Step 2: Evaluate their potential influence on the opioid crisis


- ightharpoonup Political party in power ightharpoonup how state government is managing opioid crisis based on the dominant political ideologies
- ► Altitude → respiratory depression (direct cause of opioid-related deaths)
- ► Minimum wage → ability to purchase opioids
- Veterans: disabled, unemployed, impoverished → source of prescription opioids
- Veterinarians → source of synthetic opioids




# Step 3: Analyze their effect on the opioid crisis by state

#### Correlation with:


- Total overdose death rate (per 100,000 people)

- Opioid prescription rate (per 100 people)





#### INFORMED RECOMMENDATIONS



- 1. Collect more data on number of veterans suffering from the misuse of and addiction to opioids.
- 2. Examine positive associations between prescription opioid-related deaths and number of veterans (specifically unemployed, impoverished, and disabled) upon excluding 3-5 outliers per graph.
- 3. Focus resources (treatments, rehabilitation) on veterans to mitigate and hopefully resolve the crisis.
